  - This novel, written in 1927, is considered the best and most successful of the early mysteries. There is a full complement of characters populating the cozy English village of King's Abbot: Major Blunt, Colonel Carter, Miss Gannett, the butler, the housekeeper, the narrator, Dr. Sheppard, and his know-it-all sister, and, of course, the amazing Hercule Poirot and his “little grey cells”. There are clues with a capital C to mislead us. The listener gets so involved with the numerous red herrings (or not) that the very simple truth eludes the puzzler. A classic of the mystery genre and essential for any fiction collection.
